**Re: Employee Screening Pilot Tests Begin May 5<sup>th</sup>**

Employee screening pilot tests start this coming Monday, May 5<sup>th</sup>. They are scheduled to run for 90 days, with a report due to Congress on the results in early September. In preparation for the tests, TSA Transportation Sector Network Management's (TSNM) Marie DiRocco visited each location to meet with the airport operators and local TSA staff, as well as to see the physical layout of the test airports. According to TSA, as the tests' progress, TSNM staff and the contractor, Homeland Security Institute (HSI), performing the data collection and analysis will visit each airport at various stages to observe the process, collect data, and *document any impact on airport operations*.

TSA will also continue to meet with the airports and TSA field staff to obtain their feedback and address issues or concerns. We will keep you apprised.

As a reminder, seven airports are participating in the tests. The airports and type of screening methods include the following:

<b>100 Percent Perimeter Screening</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 100 percent employee and vehicle screening at airport perimeter entrances for 90 days</li><li>• 100% from one terminal for 30 days</li><li>• 100 % from cargo facilities for 30 days</li><li>• Use of biometric access control</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Boston's Logan International, MA</li></ul>

<p><b>100 Percent Checkpoint Screening</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 100 percent physical employee screening from the public area to the secure area (SIDA)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jacksonville International, FL</li> <li>• Craven Regional, New Bern, NC</li> </ul>
