DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: The Broward County, Florida - Aviation Department which manages Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport (FLL) and North Perry Airport (HWO), its general aviation facility, seeks a professional Project Manager III to work in the Airport Expansion Program section of the Aviation Development Division. This is advanced professional and administrative work managing large construction projects at the Airport. Responsibilities include providing direction to the capital program using strong contract administration skills and sound judgment.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in civil engineering or field of specialization appropriate to area of assignment; four (4) years progressively responsible experience in the design, construction and management of construction projects, including supervisory experience; or any equivalent combination of relevant training and experience.

NOTE: Applicants selected for employment with the Aviation Department will be subject to extensive security screening, including but not limited to fingerprint checks, employment verification, and such other procedures as may be mandated by Federal Law as a continuing condition of employment.

A valid Florida driver's license is required, and the successful applicant must be able to obtain and maintain federally mandated security clearances for working at an airport.
