DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: The Broward County Aviation Department seeks an Airport Operations Senior Agent (Airside Officer). This is responsible technical and lead work in the airside operations at Fort Lauderdale - Hollywood International Airport or North Perry Airport. Involves overseeing and coordinating resources and implementing work procedures to ensure a safe, efficient and secure environment for passengers, airport personnel, vehicles, equipment and movement of aircraft within established airport policies and FAA regulations. Performs related work as required. Requires weekend and shift work.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Bachelor's Degree in airport management or related field; and two years in airport operations, including general aviation operations experience; or any equivalent combination of training and experience. Valid Florida Driver's License required.

NOTE: Applicants selected for employment with the Aviation Department will be subject to extensive security screening, including but not limited to fingerprint checks, employment verification and such other procedures as may be mandated by Federal Law as a continuing condition of employment.
