

DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS PUBLIC SAFETY

Dane County Regional Airport in Madison, Wisconsin (**MSN**) is seeking an individual to assess, evaluate and manage airport operations activities, safety and security programs. This position ensures compliance with a multitude of regulatory agencies. Requires any combination of training and experience equivalent of a Bachelor's degree in airport management, business administration, aeronautical engineering, or related field and a minimum of five (5) years of progressively responsible management experience, including three (3) years of supervisory experience at an air carrier (Part 139) airport, or equivalent military facility involving aircraft operations. Possession of a private pilot's license or air traffic operations experience are preferred. Candidates appointed to a position at the Dane County Regional Airport must pass a Transportation Security Administration (TSA) required criminal history records check and employment history verification. Plus, a pre-employment drug and alcohol test is required.
