The Broward County Aviation Department Operations/Security Division has two openings for Aviation Security Compliance Specialists. The Security Compliance Specialists are responsible for assisting with compliance and monitoring programs currently in place at the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport as well as providing security awareness to the public, passengers, tenants and staff.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from an accredited four (4) year college or university with major course work in airport management, business or public administration, or related field; four (4) years experience in aviation security coordination, including anti-terrorism procedures and protection of airport assets; or any equivalent combination of relevant training and experience.

The work schedule includes afternoon, evening or night shifts, weekends and holidays. * An extensive ten (10) year work history verification and criminal background check, including fingerprinting and all other information as required by the Federal Aviation Administration. * Post-offer physical examination including drug testing. * Ability to maintain authorization to drive a County vehicle. * Ability to obtain and maintain a Security Identification Display Area (SIDA) Badge. * The Aviation Department operates under a Drug-Free Workplace Policy in compliance with the provisions of the Federal Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid Florida Driver's License. Must be able to secure and maintain compliance with airport security identification badge requirements and comply with all security and criminal background check requirements.

NOTE: Applicants selected for employment with the Aviation Department will be subject to extensive security screening, including but not limited to fingerprint checks, employment verification, and such other procedures as may be mandated by Federal Law as a continuing condition of employment.

The Aviation Department operates under a Drug-Free Workplace Policy in compliance with the provisions of the Federal Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988. A valid Florida driver's license is required, and the successful applicant must be able to obtain and maintain federally mandated security clearances for working at an airport.
