

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

San Francisco International Airport Airline Liaison Office Consultant Services

San Francisco International Airport is soliciting proposals from qualified consultants to provide airline liaison office ("ALO") consulting services between the Airport and the San Francisco Airline Airport Affairs Committee. This professional service contract has an initial term of five (5) years with two one-year options to extend, at the Airport Commission's discretion.

Respondents must be able to demonstrate the following Minimum Qualification Requirements: At least three years of experience, within the last five years in facilitating airport/airline affairs for an airport located in the United States designated by the Federal Aviation Administration as a large hub primary airport, which provides international airline service beyond North America.

A pre-proposal conference is scheduled on Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time.
