Airport Communications Technician (Requisition: 18-0012)

The Airport Communications Technician is responsible for performing airport surveillance, monitoring access, and receiving calls in the Airport Communications Center (ACC). Other responsibilities include dispatching aircraft rescue and firefighting (ARFF) emergency units to an accident scene, communicating with emergency and law enforcement departments, and monitoring emergency and non-emergency communication systems.

- Uses electronic equipment including the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) and Metro ARMS to determine vehicle registration, criminal history, warrants, stolen property, gun files, and emergency notifications.
- Dispatches personnel to investigate complaints, security infractions, and reported emergency and medical situations.
- Maintains communication throughout emergency situations, including with field units and callers, local emergency and law enforcement departments, airport personnel, and air traffic control (ATC) tower.

Some college in a related field required. One to three years of call taking, law enforcement, dispatching, or related experience required.
