**CONTINUING ISSUES AND PROPOSED SOLUTIONS FOR EFFECTIVE IDENTITY VERIFICATION**

*Nothing is more fundamental to a security program than knowing exactly who we are providing security credentials to and that they are who they say they are. Dennis Treece will summarize the issue for the distinguished panel of experts.
