Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Indianapolis Airport Authority (IAA) in Indianapolis, Indiana for the sale of thirty-four (34) passenger loading bridges and associated aircraft ground power units as well as a considerable amount of spare parts. Having completed the construction of a new facility the IAA has excess passenger loading bridges and spare parts for sale to the highest bidder. A portion of the bridges have 60kva, and others 90kva aircraft ground power units attached. Bridges and spare parts are being sold *as-is*, and there is no guarantee attached to this sale. Spare parts will be sold as a separate bid from the bridges. All sales are final. The successful bidder will be expected to remove purchased bridges and spare parts from the IAA property within 60 days of notification of accepted bid.

Interested bidders may view the bridges on the IAA property at 2500 S. High School Road on Thursday, June 18 and Tuesday, June 23 between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
