POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Manager of Financial Planning & Analysis reports to the Finance Director at the San Francisco International Airport and is responsible for planning, directing and overseeing the day-to-day operations of the section including Rates & Charges, Revenue Budgeting, Revenue Forecasting and Tracking, Financial and Economic Reporting, Air Traffic Forecasting, Financial Modeling and Analysis, and Data Collection Systems. Example of duties: directing staff in the development of the Airport's rates, fees and charges; managing staff responsible for financial, economic and statistical analyses, forecasts and reports, revenue projections, cost recovery analyses, air traffic analyses and multi-year projections; providing financial modeling and analysis; administering, monitoring and improving the activity reporting systems to ensure accurate data of air traffic statistics and concession activity and revenues; directing the development and implementation of fiscal policies and analysis; and working with local community representatives, local, state and federal agencies, Airport senior staff and managers, and tenant groups.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Possession of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university; **AND**
2. Seven (7) years financial evaluation experience, including two (2) years of rate setting experience
