

**City of San Jose Airport Department**  
**Request for Qualifications - Airport Economic Analysis Services**

The City of San Jose Airport Department has issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) on January 6, 2010, from consultants capable of providing a broad range of economic and fiscal analytical services related to the existing and future operation and development of the Norman Y. Mineta San Jose International Airport (SJC). Typical tasks may include: quantitative and qualitative economic impacts of airline or other aviation services on SJC and local community/region; cost/revenue projections of alternative SJC development scenarios; aviation-related surveys of area businesses, residents, and visitors; demographic/economic analysis in support of aviation service and opportunity cost analysis of loss of service or under-utilization of facility assets; and evaluation of relevant studies prepared by other agencies or airports.
