Southwest now flies all Next Generation aircraft including the new MAX 8

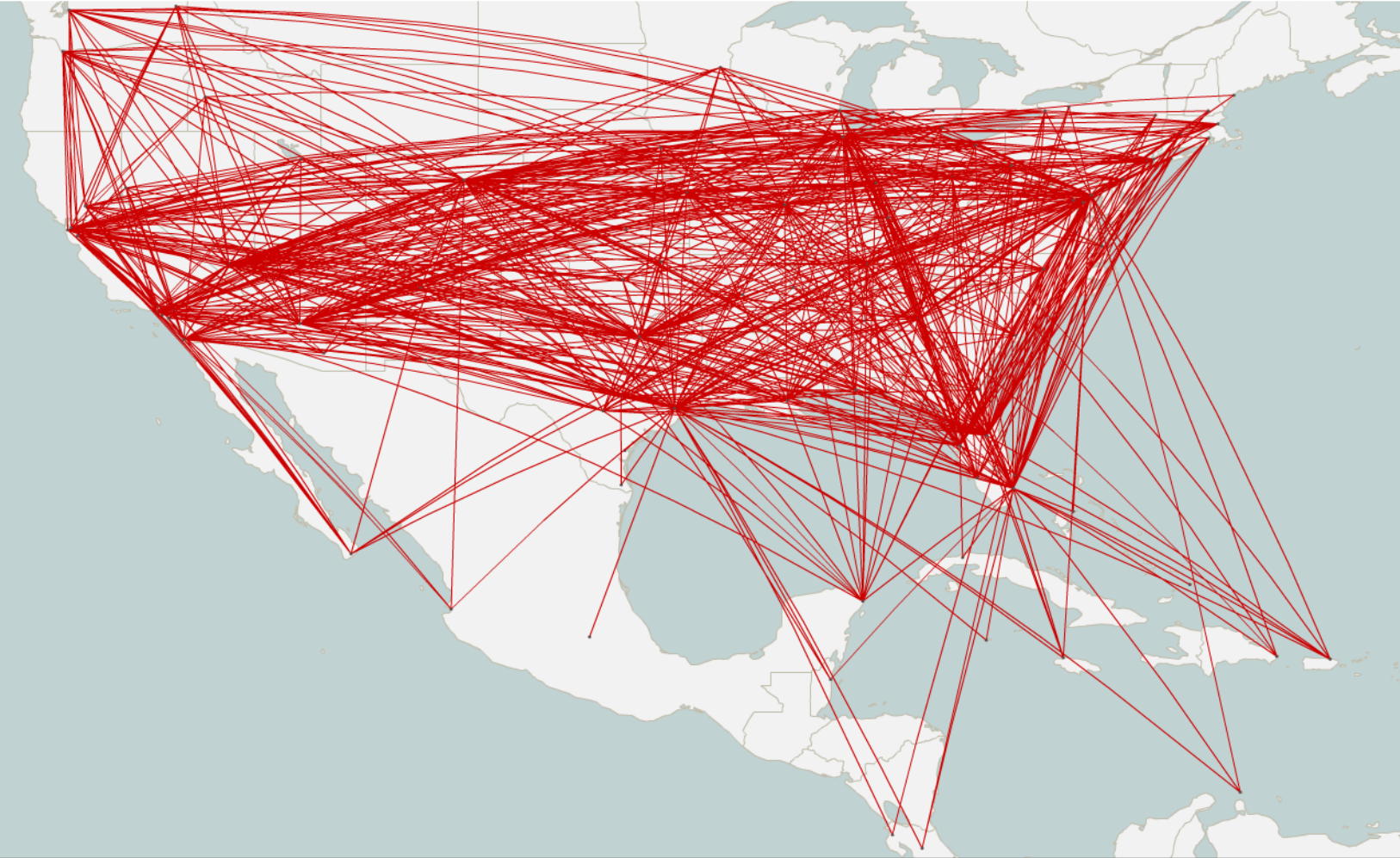
Overview

- Classic fleet retired by September 30, 2017
- Southwest now operates an entire fleet of Wi-Fi equipped aircraft post Classic fleet retirement
- New Boeing MAX 8 aircraft entered service October 1, 2017 and seats 175 passengers
- Older 737-800 interiors retrofit to our new, more comfortable Heart interior featuring:
 - adjustable headrest
 - lower profile armrest
 - advanced lumbar support
- The Company continues to focus on fleet modernization
- Southwest expects to end 2018 with ~750 aircraft, returning to normal fleet levels

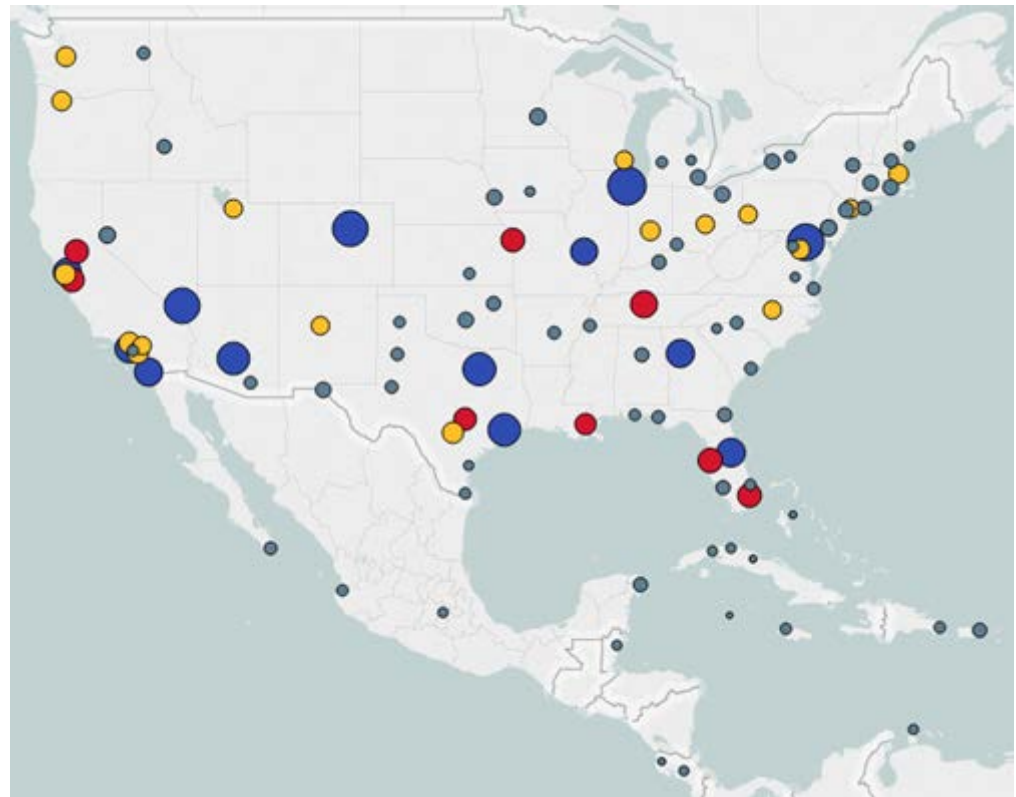
